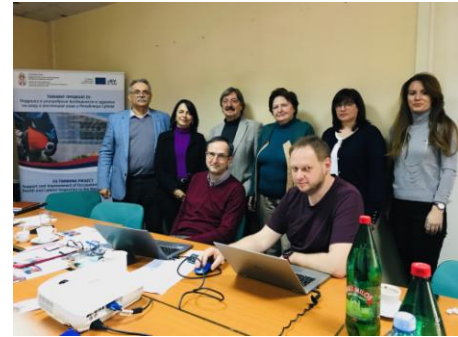


Consultative Meeting with Social Partners on OSH Campaigns in 2020 within Twinning Project “Support and Improvement of Occupational Safety and Health and Labor Inspection in the RS”

In the framework of the Twinning Project “Support and Improvement of Occupational Safety and Health and Labor Inspection in the RS”, a consultative meeting was organized on February 24, 2020 in the OSH Directorate regarding organization of awareness raising campaigns focused on improvement of knowledge and social responsibility of all stakeholders, as well as building a positive attitude of public to safety and health at work. The OSH national campaigns 2020 will be organized by the Directorate of Safety and Health at Work of MLEVSA with support of the Twinning Project and participation of social partners and other stakeholders. The tri-partite meeting was attended by representatives of Serbian Association of Employers (UPS), Trade Unions (UGS Nezavisnost), OSH Union (UBZRS), Labour Inspectorate, OSH Directorate of MLEVSA and Twinning Project experts.



The first campaign “Good Safety promotes Good Business” aims to promote investment into Safety and Health at Work targeting specifically employers. This campaign will be organized in March-April 2020 and one of the key activities of the campaign is National Prize Awarding in the area of Safety and Health at Work on 28 April, 2020 (World OSH Day and OSH day in the RS). Two other campaigns planned to be implemented in 2020 will follow in May-June 2020 and October- November 2020 and will cover topics of Safety at Construction Sites and Prevention of work related musculoskeletal disorders.

As of February 2019, The Directorate of OSH of MLEVSA and Labour Inspection has been implementing two-year Twinning Project “Support and Improvement of Occupational Safety and Health and Labor Inspection in the RS” through partnership of the Ministry of Labour, Employment, Veteran and Social Affairs of the Republic of Serbia, Ministry of Labour, Social Affairs and Family of the Slovak Republic, the State Labour Inspection Office of the Czech Republic and Regional Development Agency Senec-Pezionok, Slovak Republic. The Contracting Authority is RS Ministry of Finance, Department for Contracting and Financing of the EU Funded Programmes. The project is funded by the European Union in the amount of 1,5 million euro.
